

**CLASS RANKINGS**

All rankings of students will be based on a weighted system. Students will be given a weighted grade of 1.05 for college and AP classes and 1.03 for Regents classes. To receive the AP weighting the student needs to sit for the exam. A student's class ranking will be calculated at the end of their 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of their graduating year.

The Valedictorian of the graduating class will be the student with the highest weighted grade point average and the Salutatorian will be the student with the second highest weighted grade point average at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of their graduating year.

To be considered in class rankings, a student must be a full time Eldred student. To participate in the graduation ceremonies, students need to have fulfilled all graduation requirements.
